

PRAYER IN THE GARDEN: SUNDAY, JUNE 28

Our first “Prayer in the Garden” worship was well received, so we will try another pair of services this Sunday, June 28 at 9:00a and 9:45a.

SPECIAL NOTE ON SOCIAL DISTANCING: Everyone must either wear a mask or remain a safe distance of 6+ feet away from everyone else. Combining a mask with distancing is even better.

Nobody likes doing this, but that doesn't matter: our priority is health and safety. If you're not sure that you can manage this, I respectfully request that you stay at home.

We had slip-ups on this at our first Prayer in the Garden services. Our ability to maintain safety at these services will be a factor in determining how we worship during the remainder of the pandemic; specifically: if, how, and when we can return to the sanctuary. Thank you.

These services will have the following features:

- Held on Sunday morning, June 28, at 9:00a and 9:45a
- In and above Memorial Garden (If weather is inclement, the event will be cancelled by a phone call to you)
- 35 minutes long
- Prayer, hymns (listening only), brief homily
- Terry will lead, speaking from near the bottom of Memorial Garden stairs; he will also play keyboard from there
- Up to 6 people (or families) who *don't* climb stairs can be seated in chairs around the top fence of the garden at 8' distances from each other
- Up to 6 people (or families) who *do* climb stairs can be seated on the lower level of the garden itself at 8' distances from each other
- There will be two time options (exactly the same service): 9:00-9:35a and 9:45-10:20a, thereby accommodating a total of up to 24 individuals/families.
- Someone will be in the parking lot to assist you as you arrive.
